JUNIOR BUILDING ENGINEER

Rail Baltica is the largest Baltic transport infrastructure project that will create the North – East economic corridor. It will be an electrified, high speed railway line with modern infrastructure for passenger and freight services, ensuring environmentally friendly and fast transportation from Tallinn to the Lithuanian-Polish border. Rail Baltica will connect the Baltic States with Central and Western Europe. The project is largely co-financed by the European Union. It must be well-governed, with clear financial flows and procurement systems. RB Rail AS is looking for a new enthusiastic **colleague** to join our growing team in a position of **JUNIOR BUILDING ENGINEER**.

Our ambition is to plan, monitor and control the delivery the new best-in-class, innovative, environmentally friendly railway infrastructure with cost competitive technical solution in the region to improve the long-term well-being of the society of the Baltic States and European community. RB Rail AS is the three Baltic States' joint venture, it was established in October 2014 and is registered in Latvia. Main business of the joint venture is the design, construction and marketing of the railway. RB Rail acts as a main coordinator of the project.

JOB PURPOSE

The primary responsibilities of the Junior Building Engineer are to support in planning, analysis and detailing of building design/construction tenders on the Pan Baltic level. To follow on design and construction works for Rail Baltica. As well as to follow the work programmes of the designers and contractors ensuring of that the requirements of Rail Baltica Design Guidelines, local construction norms, procedures of the construction process are followed. To perform spot checks for the point-type objects on the Rail Baltica main line with aim to collect data on actual progress and prepare an overview on further solutions / activities.

QUALIFICATION

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent in Civil Engineering.
- 2+ years' experience in design and/or design supervision or practical experience on the construction site.
- Experience with the MS Office Suite, AutoCAD, MS Project or other similar planning tools.
- Understanding of the local and International (i.e. Eurocodes) construction and design standards would be a great advantage.
- Previous experience participating in project management activities would be a great advantage (e.g., project management assistant role).
- Well-developed communication skills, with ability to effectively interact with both the business partners and internal technical team members.
- Good understanding of technical English and fluent Latvian.
- Resilient to coping with conflicting demands, able to prioritize duties and work under pressure.
- High ethical standards, honesty and impeccable reputation.
- Strive for continuous improvement and precision in every detail.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- To follow on building design and construction process in accordance with the Rail Baltica Design Guidelines and other relevant national requirements.
- Review of design solutions, specifications, cost estimates, overseeing geometric layouts, checking of design calculations, assigning work and overseeing work products produced by consultants.
- Participation in Construction Logistics and other studies in cooperation with Implementing Bodies and representatives of Technical Division.
- Coordinate supervision process and propose improvements when necessary, in scope of own knowledge and experience.
- Do necessary revision of technical safety and security matters for Rail Baltica project stations and buildings.
- Participate in the activity budgeting process including proposal of supporting activities and their budgets.
- Working closely with the national Implementing Bodies.
- In accordance with the employer's request and within the scope of the work responsibilities, to participate in the preparation of technical specifications and participate at the RB Rail AS public procurement committees, as well as act as RB Rail representative in procurement exercises of the national implementing bodies.

ORGANISATION REPORTING STRUCTURE

Junior Building Engineer is a part of the Civil Works and Station Department of the Technical Division and reports to Senior Construction and Hydrology Expert. Daily working and coordination with other members of Technical Division. Close cooperation with Beneficiaries and Implemented Bodies.
