

**Answers to the questions from the interested suppliers
in open competition "Web development and maintenance Services"

RB Rail AS presents the following answers to the questions received until 28 June 2018 from the interested suppliers:

No	Questions	Answers
1.	Did we understand the requirement correctly? During the development of the project (Technical proposal) is planned to create a new section in the main menu for the infographic, which choosing the user will be redirected to a new page (developed by the Tenderer), which will contain the infographic content from the Documentation Library -> Infographics page (http://www.railbaltica.org/about-rail-baltica/documentation/) ?	Procurement commission indicates, that the creation of the new section for infographic should be considering only as a task (i.e. Technical proposal) to prepare a concept for a new section in the main page, devoted to the infographics.
2.	Wanted to clarify is it really necessary that Web developer has experience with at least 2 OctoberCMS project that are at least 2 multi-level and at least in 3 languages? Or this requirement only applies to Wordpress projects?	Procurement commission indicates that According to Section 7.5. (1.4) Clause 1 and Clause 2 of Regulation: the Web developer has to have experience with projects that are at least 2 multi-level and at least in 3 languages, not specifying in which platforms, and requesting that the Web developer has experience with OctoberCMS with at least two projects and experience working with WordPress platform for at least 3 projects and OctoberCMS for at least 2 projects, not specifying need for multi-level and language requirements. Procurement commission indicates that these clauses are not related to each other.
