



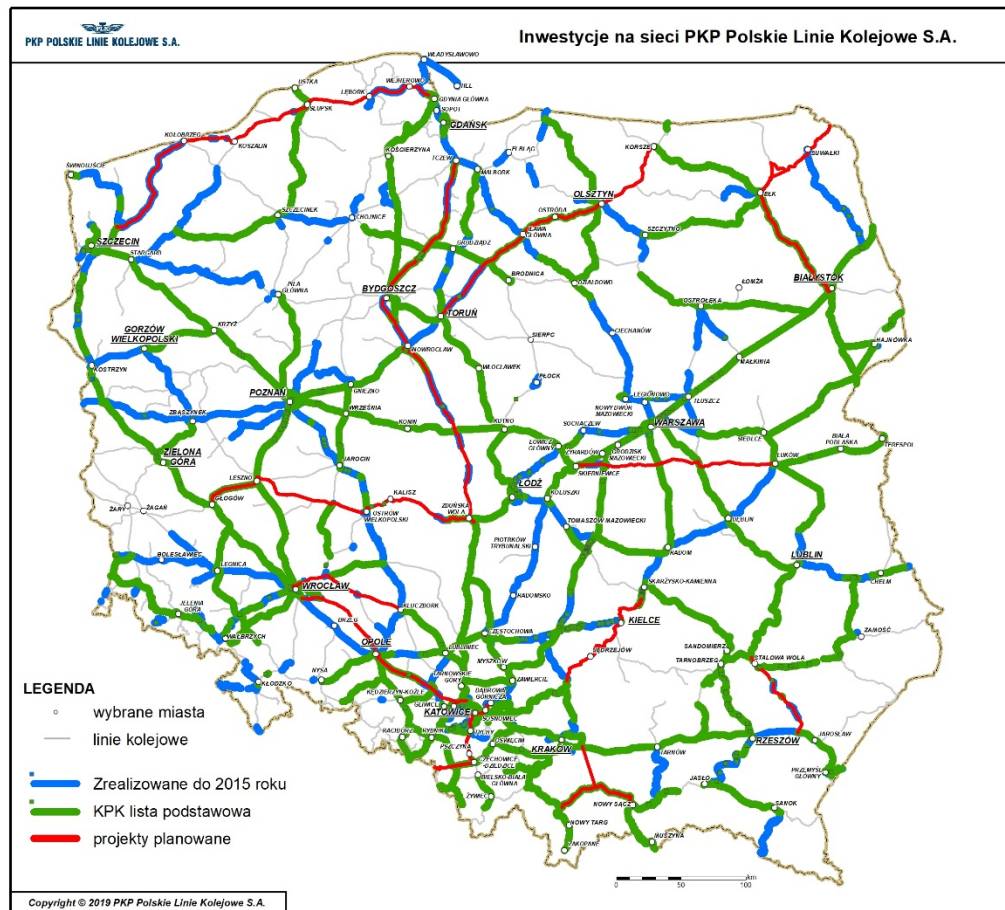

The aim of the program is to supplement the railway network with railway connections (including the preparation of necessary pre-design and design documentation) of towns with a population of over 10 000 persons without access to passenger railways with regional capitals and improvement of internal communication and socio-economic cohesion of the regions.

The Program will be implemented by PKP PLK SA in cooperation with local government units. Local government units were informed about the possibilities and of investment implementation rules.

Currently, the Ministry of Infrastructure is working on the preparation and implementation of the program and 21 investments were pre-identified. This list does not constitute a complete catalog of tasks that qualify for support.
