

RB Rail AS presents following answers to the questions received from the interested suppliers until 14 September 2020:

1	<p>We strongly urge RB Rail AS to remove the deductible requirement in article 10.9 (not more than 2,900 EUR) or raise it to 135,000 EUR, which is standard for big consultancy companies' PI Insurances.</p>	<p>Procurement commission understands that market participants depending on its size, country, financial and other parameters may have different conditions of professional insurance and in particular standard amount of deductibles. Considering risk and scope of RAMS services Procurement commission believe that defined amount of deductible is reasonable and adequate. Thus, requirements of Clause 10.9. of Draft Agreement remains unchanged.</p>
2	<p>With regard to the subject competition with ID no. RBR 2020/12, I would appreciate if you could please provide the following clarification:</p> <p>1) Regulations, Paragraphs 18.1 Verification of Technical Proposals</p> <p>It is indicated that "Technical Proposals should not exceed 20 pages on A4 paper and the font size for general text parts shall not be less than approximately size 10 in a well readable and recognisable font type".</p> <p>We kindly request to permit just a few A3 paper formats (around 3 pages maximum) within the 20 pages of the Technical Proposal. In this way, we could include organization charts, work schedules, etc. in a better readable format.</p>	<p>Hereby Procurement Commission explains that Technical proposal formatting is defined as A4. Considering that all proposals will be submitted electronically there is no need for A3 format, since it is possible use zoom function.</p> <p>Thus, Section 18.1 of Regulations remains unchanged.</p>
