RB Rail AS presents following answers to the questions received from the interested supplier until 3 September 2020:

1.	<p>If the basis for the demand model is a standard software (e.g. Visum), the source codes are not available to the tenderer and the intellectual property cannot be transferred to RBR.</p> <p>Is it acceptable that in this case, only source codes for add-on scripts are provided (incl. source code and property rights)?</p>	<p>Yes, it is acceptable. Procurement commission indicates that, if a commercial software is used for the implementation of the transport demand model, then the standard licensing terms for that software must apply to the scope of that software. 2.	<p>Are Visum licenses already available at RBR or (if not) can they be acquired outside of the project, or do we need to include the 3<sup>rd</sup> party license costs (PTV) in our offer?</p>	<p>In accordance with the Section 2.2 of the Technical specification (Annex 1 of the open competition "<b>Rail Baltica Transport demand model development and analysis</b>" regulations), if a commercial software is required for running and/or changing the source code of the DM and/or of its web-interface, the proposed contract price must also include:</p> <p>1) the cost of the purchase in favor of RBR of 2 (two) software licenses for installation on</p>

		<p>RBR systems that could be used in parallel and not limited in time;</p> <p>2) the cost necessary for running and/or changing the source code of the model and/or of its web-interface.</p> <p>Taking into account mentioned before, if the basis for the transport demand model is a commercial software, costs of the purchase in favor of RB Rail AS of 2 (two) software licenses must be included in the Financial proposal and indicated in line <b><i>"Price for one DM software license: EUR _____ (excl. VAT)"</i></b> (Annex No 8 of the open competition "Rail Baltica Transport demand model development and analysis" regulations).</p> <p>Additionally, Procurement commission indicates that RB Rail AS does not currently own any license of transport demand models development software.</p>
