It will be an electrified, high speed railway line with modern infrastructure for passenger and freight services, ensuring environmentally friendly and fast transportation from Tallinn to the Lithuanian-Polish border. Rail Baltica will connect the Baltic States with Central and Western Europe. The project is largely co-financed by the European Union. It must be well-governed, with clear financial flows and procurement systems. REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in project management, business administration, transport management, infrastructure development, EU studies or other field relevant to the Rail Baltica project; Master's degree will be viewed as an advantage.
- At least 5 years of professional experience related to the responsibilities described below, including large project management, stakeholder management, procurement, reporting and task coordination. The following experiences are particularly desirable and will be viewed as an advantage: transport infrastructure development, EU project management, international cooperation, team management/leadership roles.
- Familiarity with reporting requirements and eligibility aspects of large EU-funded infrastructure projects, as well as ability to assist in identifying new opportunities in existing and alternative EU funding schemes.
- Experience in activity-based budget planning and supervision.
- Familiarity with digital document/task management systems.
- Strong understanding of the procurement process. Experience with public procurement, ideally, in an EU funding context, will be viewed as an advantage.
