in the competitive procedure with negotiations  
“Consolidated supply of rails for Rail Baltica railway construction”,

RB Rail AS presents following answers to the questions received from the interested supplier until 22 September 2021:

Nr.	Questions	Answers
1.	As qualification conditions do not exclude supply from third countries and supplies are planned for a period of seven years, during this period quantitative quotas and respective import duties may be applied. Please clarify, whether the eventually imposed import duties will be considered as a case of force majeure, where the Supplier may change the price or refuse to deliver at all?	Based on the level of detail provided by the Candidate, the Procurement Commission hereby kindly notes that currently it is not in a position to consider that eventually imposed import duties would be considered as a <i>Force Majeure</i> event. Thus, the supplier shall foresee such risks during the preparation of the application. Eventual cost increase will be assessed in line with the draft contract, however currently there is no basis to consider that significant changes or Variations are expected due to import duties. Any full or partial suspension and/or termination of deliveries is not anticipated at current stage due to import duties unless otherwise specified in the second stage Regulations. However, please note that detailed conditions will be presented during the second stage of the procurement.
