1	<p>Regarding the ECCS system is it possible to be supported by a company not Included in the consortium as a partner?</p> <p>They could add the reference including a commitment letter?</p>	<p>The Procurement commission informs that it is not mandatory to have ECCS partner as member in the partnership. Participating in the competitive procedure with negotiations “Rail Baltica Energy Subsystem Design and Build” (ID No 2022/7) (hereinafter – Procurement), the Candidate has the right to involve the other company also as:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) a person on whose capacity the Candidate is relying, e.g., to cover the qualification criteria related to ECCS, and company (a person on whose capacity the Candidate is relying) confirms of such status and usage of their resources in case Tenderer (Candidate) will be awarded with contract rights. The Procurement commission kindly asks to the interested supplier pay attention to Section 6 <i>“Reliance on the capacities of other persons”</i> of the Procurement regulations, including the documents to be submitted; 2) subcontractor, e.g., company who will deliver ECCS part of the Procurement contract.

		<p>In this case, the Procurement commission kindly asks to the interested supplier pay attention to Section 7 "<i>Subcontracting</i>" of the Procurement regulations. In addition, the Procurement commission would like to point out that in accordance with Clause 7.1. of the Procurement regulations "<i>Candidates will be required to provide information about their subcontractors during the Second Stage of the Competition.</i>"</p> <p>The Procurement commission informs that more detailed information about subcontractors, including the documents to be submitted, will be specified in the Procurement regulations of the Second Stage.</p>
