1	Regarding "CANDIDATE SELECTION REGULATION", Article 13.1 on the Evaluation Criterion No 1, which reads "For second (inclusive) and every further project compliant with requirements defined in Section 5.3.5 of the Regulations Candidate will obtain two point per project", please confirm if the references of a supplier/subcontractor would be acceptable.	The Procurement commission explains that Section 13.1.1. of the competitive procedure with negotiations "Rail Baltica Energy Subsystem Design and Build", ID No RBR 2022/7 (hereinafter – Procurement) regulations refers to requirements defined in Section 5.3.5. of the Procurement regulations. In this case, the requirement applies to design and build experience as a main contractor not experience as a subcontractor. The procurement commission kindly asks an interested supplier to pay attention to the requirements regarding documents to be submitted of the Section No 13 "Candidate evaluation" of the Procurement regulations.
2	Regarding the Article 13.2 of the Regulation, which reads "After the ranking the Procurement commission selects all Candidates which are ranked in the first 6 (six) positions and these Candidates shall be invited to submit a Bid in the Second stage of the Competition", please clarify the method of evaluation / ranking in cases where more than 6 candidates get maximum of points (17 points).	The Procurement commission explains, that in accordance with Section 13.2. of the Procurement regulations, the Procurement commission selects all Candidates which are ranked in the first 6 (six) positions and these Candidates shall be invited to submit a Bid in the Second stage of the Competition (Procurement). It also means if several Candidates will get the same number of points in any of the first 6 (six) positions e.g., more than 6 (six) Candidates get maximum of points (17 points), then all these Candidates shall be invited to submit a Bid in the Second stage of the Competition (Procurement).
