Do all partners in a Partnership project need to be registered fully and separately in the EPS system, or is it enough to add them in the Pretender Section only?	<ul> <li>Procurement Commission kindly explains that if the Candidate is a partnership consisting of several entities:</li> <li>1) all members may submit Application in the Electronic Procurement System jointly or</li> <li>2) partnership may authorize one member to submit Application on behalf of the partnership <i>(in such case please note: partnership agreement or Letter of Intent must be concluded and attached to Application).</i></li> <li>It is not mandatory to register all members of the partnership as users of the Electronic Procurement system (EPS). At least one member who is authorized to submit Application on behalf of the partnership, shall be registered as a user of the EPS to be able to upload and sign Application in the EPS. Brief tutorial with instructions how to submit and sign the Application in the EPS is available here: http://paligs.eis.gov.lv/suppliers/.</li> </ul>
2.	Why isn't it possible to register Estonian companies as Partners or Subcontractors in the Pretender section (Estonia does not occur in the drop down menu)	Please note that if the Candidate is just relying on capabilities and capacity of other entities (not included in the partnership) in order to meet any of qualification requirements or involve sub- contractors, these entities shall not be registered as users of Electronic Procurement system.
