Procurement commission clarifies that Annex No 1 "Application for participation in the Competition" is not the only document which needs to be signed. According to Clause 9.2.2. of the regulations whole documents included in the Application (please see the Clause 9.3. of the regulations in which are stated the documents that shall be included in the Application) must be signed as follows: 1) each document signed separately with a secure electronic signature and timestamp by an authorised person, (in this case should be included its authorisation document (e.g., power of attorney) expressis verbis stating the authorisations to sign, submit and otherwise manage the documents); or 2) all documents included in the Application signed together by authorised person with a secure electronic signature and timestamp or with an electronic signature provided by the Electronic Procurement System; In addition, the Application may contain

with wet signature. These documents must be included in the Application as derivative (e.g., copy) (in this case the derivative to have a legal force should be drawn up according to requirements stipulated in Clause 9.5. of the competitive procedure with negotiations regulations and the Candidate should be ready to submit original document (which have legal force) in the reply to a request of the Procurement commission).
