In order to allow the potential candidates to set up their internal organization, for better and clearer evaluation of the scopes of this procurement, and for creating the best approach both for Contracting Authority and the Contractor, please provide information regarding the repartition of the volume of different disciplines inside CCS scope. It would be helpful to receive this repartition in exact volumes of each discipline, or at least their percental evaluation.	<p>The Procurement commission provides an indicative breakdown between the main disciplines in the table below. Please clarify can the Candidate use the References (for Technical and Professional ability) of nominated Sub-contractor during the pre-qualification stage? If yes, should nominated Sub-Contractor pass the same pre-qualification process as the Candidate?	The Procurement commission explains that the candidate may rely on the capacities of nominated sub-contractors and their references for technical and professional ability, however in this case sub-contractors are the persons on whose capacities Candidate relies as well (please see the Section 6 of the Regulation). Please be aware that in this case exclusion grounds mentioned in the Section 6.2 of the Regulation will be checked regarding the person on whose capacity Candidate relies.
