1	<p>Question submitted in Latvian: Atbilstoši Tehniskās Specifikācijas prasībām: Tehniskajā Specifikācijā ir noteikts pašrīks “Ten thousand (EUR 10 000) for Company Securities related wrongful acts and/or claims”, kas attiecas uz C sadaļu Vienlaicīgi Attiecībā uz Seguma sadaļām nav minēta prasība par “Company Securities Liability” (C sadaļa). Vai saprotam pareizi, ka Tehniskajā Specifikācijā nav iekļauta minimālā prasība iekļaut segumā C sadaļu “Company Securities Liability”?</p> <p>Question translated in English: According to the Requirements of the Technical Specification: Technical Specification defines a deductible: “Ten thousand (EUR 10 000) for Company Securities related wrongful acts and/or claims.” At the same time, within the Coverage Sections, there is no requirement mentioned for “Company Securities Liability” (Section C). Do we understand correctly that the Technical Specification does not include a minimum requirement to include Section C “Company Securities Liability” in the coverage?</p>	<p>The requirement must be interpreted as obliging the provision of Securities Claims related coverage only for the Insured Persons, thus should not be interpreted as RB Rail AS imposing an obligation for the Directors’ and Officers’ Liability Insurance policy to provide Securities Claims coverage for the Policyholder (RB Rail AS).</p> <p>Furthermore, it should be noted that the specific deductible indicated in the Technical Specification, like any other deductible specified therein, represents the maximum deductible level that may be offered. Tenderers are always permitted to propose lower deductible levels, however, no additional points will be awarded in the Procurement evaluation process for offering lower deductibles.</p>
